

Education – Continuing Education Requirements

As of November 1, 1995, all Real Estate licensees are required to complete 22.5 hours of continuing education every two years prior to their license renewal. Individuals must be aware of their own individual license date, which will tie into your continuing education requirements.

Any real estate licensee who renews their license on or after July 1, 2008, will be required to complete 22.5 hours of approved continuing education, ***three hours of which must include fair housing and/or discrimination in the sale or rental of real property or an interest in real property and one hour of agency, two hours of agency for your first renewal.*** This new law does not apply to those licensees that are exempt from the continuing education requirements. Brokers who are exempt from CE credit prior to July 1, 2008, are also exempt from the fair housing training requirement.

Code of Ethics NAR Requirement policy requires that REALTORS® take ethics training within given two-year cycles and continue to update their education in successive two-year periods thereafter **(January 2017 – December 31, 2018)**
